The letter for Mr. Azevedo regarding repairs to Mauna Loa Road given out. It will be sent to Mr. Azevedo, Jen Ruggles replacement and the Mayors Office.

Glenn makes a motion to approve the letter and send out to Mr. Azevedo, Jen Ruggles replacement and the Mayor's office. Tom seconds.

JP has a report from Loeffler Construction in regards to the original bid for potholes and beginning of road three. Speed humps, 5 humps 8 ft long 4 ft wide, 4 inches high at the highest painting and striping will be an additional \$2,000 to the original bid. Glenn makes a motion to accept and approve the start of the work Tom seconds, all agrees. To review – speed humps will be installed on roads 1-4 and 6. Road 5 will be getting gravel. Speed humps will be about 8 lots in from the end of the road. Mahea asks if existing humps can be painting, which John will discuss with Loeffler Construction.

12 abandoned vehicles have been towed. The engine that sits on the fourth road was excluded from the towing list, but Glenn will be following up to have this removed as well. Thank you Glenn for your hard work and persistence in getting this done.

A future project to keep in mind, the culvert on the first street will need to be reinforced.

A resident has mentioned her concern on the fifth road being overgrown, as well as a resident on the third road. This is a recognized issue throughout Aloha Estates. Residents will be reminded to put a "no spray" sign if they do not want poison sprayed on their property. Penny will draft up a letter to residents about this issue. Bids are being taken for this work and we will be following up. Tom volunteers to draft a letter to Aloha Estates residents.
