

Dear Officers, Board Members and General Members,

This letter is with respect to the Maunakea Road improvements and your request for speed bumps dated on January 6, 2000.

The cost of widening the road is my donation to the community, paid for by my own work and hard earned money. The community has not offered one penny for the road, and some of its members (known to me) have shown no appreciation for this gift. The addition of speed bumps, which you have requested, will raise the cost even more, but I will try to do my best to help you. However, please listen to my concerns and consider agreeing to the following:

With respect to adding the speed bumps, I have several areas of concern. These concerns arise from the possible increased inconvenience, hazards and risks facing unsuspecting drivers when they encounter the proposed speed bumps. It is likely from time to time that accidents could result, leading to property damage and/or personal injury. I am concerned for everyone and especially for those persons who are not from the community, such as public vehicles, delivery trucks, visitors and guests, etc., who would be unfamiliar with our road and the possibility of running into speed bumps. Furthermore, there is some increased risks of accidents and injury to children or others, for example if one falls while riding a bicycle, being on roller skates, etc. over the speed bumps.



Therefore, I would expect the Association and individually its officers and board members:

1. to certify that the whole community agrees to having the speed bumps installed.
2. take full and sole responsibility for handling any type of problems and complaints from any person about the road or presence of the speed bumps.
