DOG ATTACKS

On Friday, 7/12 a woman was attacked by 3 dogs on Hapu'uNani Road in Aloha Estates. She lives on 'OhiaNani Road and was walking home. Three dogs (a small, medium and larger dog) attacked her, growling, circling and eventually biting her. The smaller dog left to the side of the road, while the other 2 larger dogs exhibited aggressive behavior. The woman was taken to Urgent Care in Kea'au for medical treatment for a bite to her thigh and another bite behind her left knee. The puncture wounds were deep; the woman was hysterical, in shock and in disbelief.

The owner of the dogs let these aggressive dogs loose. He was unable to control his dogs at first; he eventually grabbed the more aggressive dog and chained them up. He takes full responsibility and has promised to remove the dogs from his property. As of Sunday, the dogs were still on the premises.

A police report was made, and the police are investigating this incident.

We ask the good people who live here in Aloha Estates to keep in mind the laws of Hawai'i in regards to pet ownership. It is your responsibility to maintain your animals within your own properties, especially if they are not very friendly. Mahalo.
